Tuesdays in New Brighton 3:30-6:30 pm @ Diamond Milling parking lot on Fifth Avenue







Don't worry if you missed the first day of sales, mark your calendars for next week (and each week thereafter). The markets run through late autumn.

The Beaver County Office on Aging will again distribute SENIORS FARMERS MARKET NUTRITION PROGRAM vouchers. Any Beaver County resident age 60 or older and meeting income guidelines is eligible to receive \$24 worth of Farmers Market Vouchers. Income guidelines are: 1 person household \$23,828 or 2 person household \$32,227

To receive your vouchers, you must complete an application and mail it back to the Office on Aging beginning May 3rd. Calls will be taken Monday through Friday between 9 am and 2 pm at 724/847-2262. Please do NOT leave a message. Applications are also available at the information table located at the front entrance of The Center at the Mall (Beaver Valley Mall in Center Township).

Their office will begin mailing the vouchers on June 1st. Many of our farmers accept the vouchers. If we do, our tables will display a sign or just ask us personally. The vouchers will expire November 30th.

Many of us also accept WIC vouchers as well.

We vendors are excited to begin a new season and look forward to serving our customers again. You can buy flower & vegetable plants, home-made meals, baked goods, and of course fruits & vegetables that are ready to harvest. Remember, that in the early weeks of the market season, there are not as many fruits & vegetables ready to pick. So be patient, come back each week and see what new products will be added. You'll be amazed at how quickly the tables get full of goodies that you can buy.
